

TEXAS BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
February 15, 2024, Board Meeting Disciplinary & Administrative Actions

Roark Consulting LLC, Higley, AZ; Case Number B-42391

Violation: Roark Consulting LLC engaged in the practice of engineering without being registered with the Board. By offering or engaging in the practice of engineering in Texas and not being registered with the Board, Roark Consulting LLC is subject to administrative penalties.

Act/Rule Violated: Tex. Occ. Code §1001.405(b)(1) and 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§137.77(a) and 137.77(e).

Resolution: Cease and Desist Order and Administrative Penalty of \$500.

Ruben Gregg Saxon, R.P.L.S. #5669, Mineola, TX; Case Number D-38732

Violation: Mr. Saxon failed to follow the footsteps of the original land surveyor and failed to follow the documented records of the land title affecting the boundaries being surveyed.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §§663.16(2) and 663.16(3).

Resolution: Reprimand and an Administrative Penalty of \$1,500.

Jordan Reeves Garrett, R.P.L.S. #6154, Blanco, TX; Case Number D-40419

Violation: Mr. Garrett issued a misleading document by signing and sealing a surveying document that grossly misplaced the location of the county line and failed to respond fully and truthfully to a Board inquiry within 30 days after the inquiry was received.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §§661.60(a) and 663.10(7).

Resolution: Reprimand and an Administrative Penalty of \$3,000.

Enrique C. Elizondo, R.P.L.S. #6386, San Antonio, TX; Case Number D-40936

Violation: Mr. Elizondo participated in a plan, scheme, or arrangement having as its purpose the evasion of the Professional Land Surveying Practices Act by signing and sealing professional surveying work done by two individuals whose work he did not supervise. Also, Mr. Elizondo allowed his professional seal to be used in any manner, whatsoever, so as to create the opportunity for the unauthorized practice of professional surveying by any person. Mr. Elizondo aided and abetted two unlicensed persons in connection with the unauthorized practice of professional surveying.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §§663.10(3), 663.10(6), and 663.10(8).

Resolution: Five Year Probated Suspension contingent upon successful completion of the TTU Surveying Ethics Advanced Course and remittance of an Administrative Penalty of \$4,500.
