

TEXAS BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
May 21, 2026, Board Meeting Disciplinary & Administrative Actions

Taylor Cade Watson, P.E. #128273, Katy, TX; Case Number D-43010

Violation: Mr. Watson failed to notify the board in writing not later than 30 days after a misdemeanor or felony criminal conviction.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin. Code §137.5(c).

Resolution: Formal Reprimand and successful completion of TTU Engineering Ethics Basic Level Course.

George Enrique Lazaro, P.E. #93696, La Feria, TX; Case Number D-43193

Violation: Mr. Lazaro failed to mark a set of engineering documents as preliminary and include text indicating the purpose for which the preliminary documents were being released instead of the engineer's seal.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §137.33(e).

Resolution: Formal Reprimand and Administrative Penalty of \$750.

Kelly Caitlin Sullivan, P.E. #136760, Kenosha, WI; Case Number D-43230

Violation: Ms. Sullivan failed to respond to the Board in writing to all written requests for information regarding all inquiries under the jurisdiction of the Board within 21 days of receipt or by the date specified in board correspondence.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §137.51(c).

Resolution: Formal Reprimand and Administrative Penalty of \$750.

James P. Walkoviak, R.P.L.S. #5971, Tomball, TX; Case Number D-43067

Violation: Mr. Walkoviak issued an oral or written assertion in the practice of land surveying that was misleading or tended to create a misleading impression and failed to conduct research of adequate thoroughness to support the determination of the location of the boundaries of the land being surveyed.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§663.10(7) and 663.16(3)(B).

Resolution: One Year Probated Suspension contingent upon successful completion of 15 hours of Board-approved Continuing Education on Boundary Construction and remittance of an Administrative Penalty of \$3,000.

George Edward Lucas, R.P.L.S. #4160, Hutto, TX; Case Number D-43087

Violation: Mr. Lucas issued an oral or written assertion in the practice of land surveying that was misleading or tended to create a misleading impression and failed to follow the documented records of the land title affecting the boundaries being surveyed by failing to assume the responsibility for such research of adequate thoroughness to support the determination of the location of the boundaries of the land being surveyed.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §§138.57(a)(3) and 138.85(3)(B).

Resolution: Reprimand and an Administrative Penalty of \$1,000.

Kenneth Allen Zollinger, R.P.L.S. #5312, Sanger, TX; Case Number D-43178

Violation: Mr. Zollinger failed to practice surveying in a careful and diligent manner and issued a written document in the practice of surveying that was misleading or created a misleading impression.

Act/Rule Violated: 22 Tex. Admin Code §§138.57(a)(3) and 138.63(b)(6).

Resolution: One Year Probated Suspension contingent upon remittance of an Administrative Penalty of \$2,500.
