### **Proposed Rules**

### **TBPELS Proposes Rules to Implement Recent Bills**

With the conclusion of the 89<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the Texas Legislature, several bills were passed that impact the professions of engineering and land surveying. At the August 2025 Board Meeting, rule proposals related to these changes were approved to be published for public comment. The rules will be available for viewing and comment on the TBPELS website and in the Texas Register starting on October 17.

Rules were proposed related to the following bills:

SB681 – related to moving PE and RPLS renewals to a two-year cycle

SB1259 – related to changes to the surveying practices act, including decoupling of the FS exam

SB1080 – related to licensure for certain applicants with criminal convictions HB5629 – related to licensure for active duty military, military veterans, and military spouses

# REMINDER: SURVEYOR APPLICANT EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS CHANGE JANUARY 1, 2026

The revised 32-hour education requirement will be in effect starting JANUARY 1, 2026, and will impact all new SIT and RPLS applicants that submit applications after that date. The board approved these changes in August 2024. For more information, see the article at PELS 2024 eNewsletter

- All requests are subject to review and approval.
- Request processing can take up to 14 working days.
- Please submit your request at least three (3) weeks prior to the proposed date of the event.
- · Rescheduling will require a new request.
- Presentations are typically 1 hour in length.
