Focus on Compliance

Signing and Sealing Professional Work

The Board's primary requirements regarding all professional engineering and land surveying work is that it is done competently and ethically, that it meets all applicable codes and standards, and that it protects the health and welfare of the public. To ensure engineering and surveying work is done in a manner consistent with these requirements, all work must be done directly by or under the direct supervision of the professional responsible for the work. Engineers and surveyors demonstrate this control and oversight has occurred by adding their official seal and signature to their final work product before it is released from their control. As part of our ongoing commitment to education and outreach we are adding a new section to our eNewsletters related to compliance, enforcement and ethics issues. We will cover a different topic each newsletter as a reminder and example of the importance of different aspects of your professional practice.
